

2022 Annual Assessment Report

Pacific Shores Subdivision

The Annual Assessment Report (Report) was prepared by the Del Norte County Community Development Department to comply with Special Condition Number 4 of Coastal Development Permit Number 1-17-0631 issued by the California Coastal Commission on January 3, 2018 and amended through immaterial amendments on February 9, 2018 and March 11, 2022.

Code Enforcement Officer Dominic Mello conducted a site visit to the Pacific Shores Subdivision on November 8th, 2022. Five new illegal dumping incidents were located during the site visit. All the roads passable were traversed during the site assessment. The following Report complies with protocol outlined in the *Del Norte County Monitoring Plan* dated December 18, 2017.


The body of the report documents the five new illegal dumping locations with photographs of the debris located.

The Report contains an Appendix that includes recorded data provided by the Del Norte Sheriff's Office for calls for service within the Pacific Shores Subdivision for this assessment year.

The California Highway Patrol Crescent City Area reported a significant increase in calls for service to the Pacific Shores area. An uptick of stolen vehicle reports in the area as well as responding to a gun related call.

The Del Norte County Sheriff's Office reported approximately 45 calls for service to the Pacific Shores area. The bulk of the 45 "calls" for service were self-initiated patrol of the area by a deputy. Citizen initiated calls for service ranged from disturbing the peace, petty theft, burglaries, criminal threats, trespassing, a deceased person and a gunshot wound. Additionally the Sheriff's Office received two calls reporting illegal dumping.
